

Report on the 2018 election for the renewal of the EuroVR Executive Committee

Introduction

According to the EuroVR statutes (article 8), the Executive Committee has to be elected every three years for a mandate of three years.

The counting method used was the same as in the previous election: Plurality at Large/Block Voting/MNTV

Individual members were registered as Voters in the OpaVote system whereas for Corporate members were asked two codes for each corporate member to the OpaVote system. These codes was delivered by email to Corporate members.

Voters

Only the EuroVR members that had paid their 2017 fees were allowed to vote. Moreover, representatives of corporate members should provide the association before the election with a proxy enabling them to vote on behalf of their organization. The voters list included 21 individual members and 13 corporate members, the latter allowed to cast two votes.

In total 80 coding votes were generated of which 26 were assigned to the 13 voting corporate members, 21 were assigned to the individual members. The remaining 33 were not assigned.

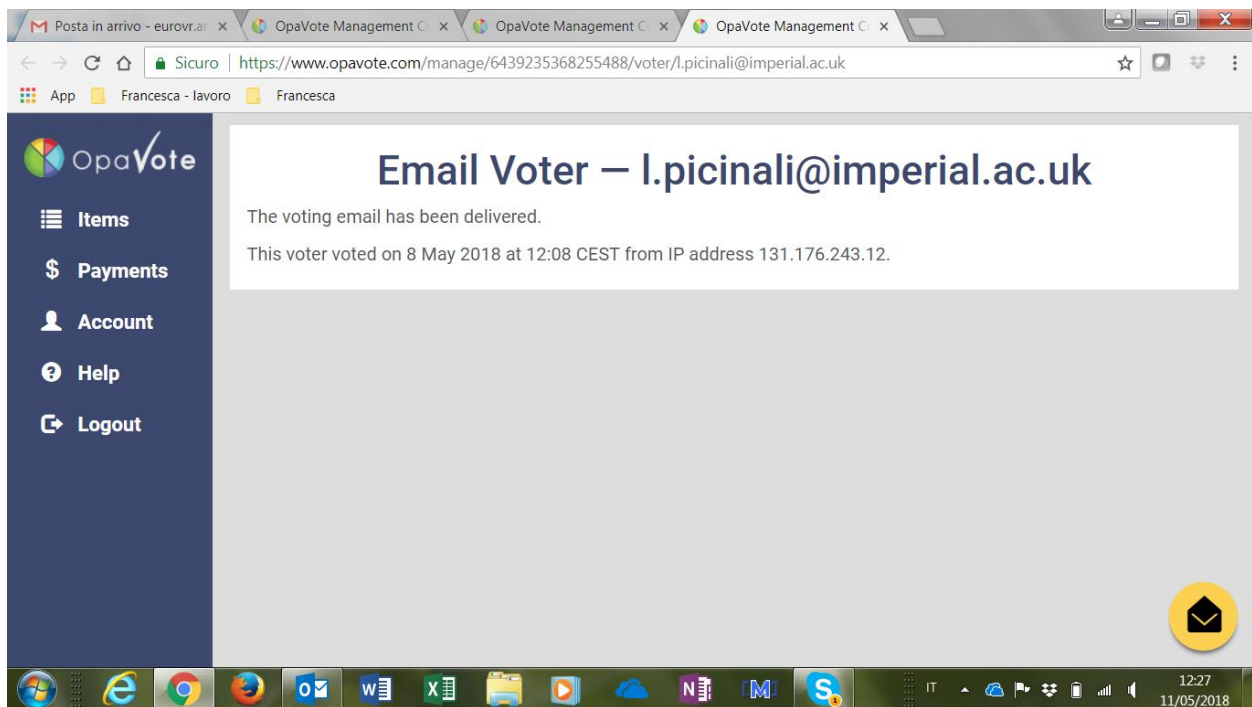
Description of the Process

- March 1st - the candidates short bios were sent to the association members by email.
- May 4th - corporate member representatives, in turn, were sent individual email messages informing them about the procedure for voting and the coding votes assigned

Some voters informed of not having received the email automatically sent by OpaVote at the opening of the election; so they were provided with a new voting code.

An individual member reported to have problems to vote because the system shew him a message indicating that he had already voted even if this member declared to have not voted yet.

The picture here below show the message showed by the OpaVote system and declaring that the member had already voted.



The association has contacted the OpaVote Manager in order to know if it was possible to cancel the vote associated to the email address indicated but the OpaVote Manager declared that it was not possible to cancel a vote once it was expressed.

So the association decided do not give another code for voting to this individual member in order not to false all the ballot.

A remainder email was sent via the OpaVote tool to registered email voters (individual members) who had not yet voted on May 9th.

A reminder email was sent via traditional email to corporate members who had not voted yet on May 10th.
